Roles include:

- Queue and crowd management
- Ticket scanning
- Distributing programs
- Greeting patrons
- Providing festival information
- Special events
- Runner

Volunteers will commit to a minimum of 5 shifts (generally 4-5 hours each) across the 12-day Festival. The volunteer team is selected based on weekend and evening availability, as well as experience, and enthusiasm.
